Operation of the school

In the month of May, 50 students from underprivileged and to greatest part from low cast families, were admitted to SWSS/ Filosofiska School.

Most of the children age, 3-14, are sponsored by Filosofiska Sweden org. and for smaller part by CHILD Street to School Switzerland org..CHILD Street to School reg. Nr 621, social walfare council aff. 33969 is monitoring the children admitted to school. The school started its operation on 1st of May 2013.

All sponsored children from poor families were provided with free educational materials. The School has also opened a kitchen and provides one warm meal and Tiffin. Transportation facilities for the children were organized as well.



The facilities of the school are as follows: one office, five classrooms, one kitchen, two toilet facilities and a small compound. By the opening of the school all the classrooms, office and the kitchen were fully furnished.
