Operation of the school:

In the month of October the school remains close from 24th September to 26th October 2014. We celebrate Dashain and Tihar. Dashain being the greatest festival for the Nepalese is always celebrated with zeal and most joyful ways. It is celebrated almost for 15 days in the month of October. 1st, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th days are most important. Dashain reunites the families and friends.

Tihar “Festival of lights” is the most beautiful and dazzling festival for the Hindus. It is the second greatest festival for Nepalese after Dashain. It is said to be festival of lights. The cities and the surroundings look very clean and wonderful with the smell and presence of the marigold flowers.

The festival usually falls in the month of October or November, celebrated for five days worshipping four different animals i.e, kaag tihar (crow tihar), kukur tihar (dog tihar), gai tihar (cow tihar), goru tihar (ox tihar). The main day to worship the goddess of wealth Laxmi and fifth day celebrated as “Bhaitika” which signifies and carries great importance for the love and concern between brothers and sisters. Tihar always brings the joyous and jolly mood in the families and friends.

For this long vacation we prepare vacation homework for the children to make them habit of reading and writing.

This month we give more focus on the home visit programs. Some of the children went to their village for the long vacation while some went to their relative/ cousins house.
